

CPF Cadastro de Pessoa Física



CPF WHAT IS THIS?

CPF is the acronym for Physical Person Registration (**Cadastro de Pessoa Física**).

It is a registration made by the Federal Revenue Service (Receita Federal) of Brazil.

Currently, the CPF is just a registration number and a physical card is no longer issued.

It is essential to carry out some cases, such as buying a cell phone line (SIM Card), opening a bank account, requesting the Single Student Ticket, among others...



CPFOUR RECOMMENDATION

As it is a very requested document for different situations and knowing the importance of obtaining a cell phone line (SIM Card) to access the internet as soon as you arrive in Brazil, we strongly recommend that students provide the CPF before coming to Brazil.



CPF HOW TO APPLY FOR CPF IN MY COUNTRY?

- 1 Jurisdiction (https://www.gov.br/mre/pt-br/assuntos/portal-consular/reparticoes-consulares-do-brasil)
- 2 Schedule the CPF request service through the e-consular system at the chosen consulate or embassy (https://econsular.itamaraty.gov.br/)
- **Documents requested:** Completed and signed <u>form</u>; Identification document (e.g. passport); Birth or marriage certificate;

CPF HOW TO APPLY FOR CPF IN BRAZIL?

Fill out the <u>CPF Request Form</u>. Enter the requested data according to your identification documents.

After filling out and submitting the form (step 1), follow the instructions that the Receita Federal will forward to you. Contact is normally made via email, so keep an eye on your inbox.


